What kind of agency – if sleep is an actor – can emerge? What new ideas of living together can develop through a collaborative exploration of sleep?

For the exhibition, which will take place from March 2023 to June 2023 we are looking for exploratory artistic practices of all formats and techniques that touch the following themes:

sleep deprivation, restless sleep, colonised sleep, interspecies\_sleep, queering sleep, repair and sleep, sleepy bourgeoisie...
