During the times for the personal submission of portfolios computer terminals will be available for online registration as well.

Please note:

It is expected that the applicants submit independent artistic works which illustrate certain interests, realisations and motivations as well as methods of work. The selection of works should be based on the applicant's own artistic practice. It is recommended that works, which have been produced in secondary school or various artcourses, be submitted only when they support the applicant's own personal artistic position.

The work samples should serve to demonstrate the applicant's aptitude for independent artistic thinking and working, there are no requirements concerning quantity or size.

However, due to technical reasons online submissions have to be limited to 1 GB.

**Viewing of submitted works:** April 24 – April 29, 2014  
(without applicants)

### **Announcement of the preliminary results: April 30, 2014**

All applicants will be notified by e-mail about the preliminary results and the list of those invited to take the entrance examination will be published on the official Academy notice board.

The works of applicants who have not been invited to take the entrance examination must be retrieved in person between 10 am and 4 pm on April 30 or May 2, 2014 at Lehargasse 8/2nd floor, 1060 Wien.

The Academy of Fine Arts Vienna shall not be liable for the portfolios submitted and cannot be expected to send back the works submitted or produced during the

examination.

**Entrance Examination:** June 30 and July 1 and 2, 2014, each day from 9 am – 5 pm  
During the entrance examination invited applicants have to be present in person to produce work samples. Applicants are allowed to work freely, there will be no special themes or techniques required. Work materials cannot be offered by the Academy and therefore will have to be brought along by applicants. The works produced during the examination will be added to the works in the submitted portfolios after those three days. During these days there will be also individual interviews with professors.

**Interviews with the Board of Admissions** will be held on July 3, 2014, from 9 am onwards (in chronological order, by number).

**Announcement of the final results:** July 4, 2014

A list of the applicants admitted to study at the Academy of Fine Arts Vienna will be published at the official notice board on July 4, 2014. In addition all applicants will be notified by e-mail about the final results.

The works submitted can be retrieved in person between 10 am and 4 pm on July 4, 7 or 8, 2014 also at Lehargasse 8/2nd floor, 1060 Wien. They cannot be returned by post.
