Presentation in English

The thesis takes as its point of departure the claim that capitalist expansion is destructive to livelihoods and to the environment, in regard to a limit to capital's resources, manifested in the various crises worldwide. It looks at "new colonialisms" as governmental agendas towards the limits to capital and the complicity and historical agendas of educational reforms and rising knowledge economies as forming "new frontiers" for capitalism, whilst examining the recent protest movements in the fields related to capital's "new frontiers," with a special focus on the international university struggles of 2008–2010. As an answer to the manifold problems faced between political agendas as well as resistant activity against them, the thesis finally proposes new modes of collective struggle for social justice through translocal organization of alternative models of learning and knowledge.

Lina Dokuzovic is an artist and PhD candidate at the Academy of Fine Arts Vienna. She is the chairwoman of the VBKÖ (Austrian Association of Women Artists / Vereinigung bildender Künstlerinnen Österreichs) and researcher on the WWTF project "Creating Worlds" of the platform EIPCP (European Institute for Progressive Cultural Policies).
