<u>The portfolio</u> should contain personal projects and work samples as also your final bachelor project. In case your Bachelor project is not finished by 03.05.2023, please hand in a preview of the work. Please bring your finalized bachelor project to the interview.

All works have to be handed in in digital format. Please hand in your portfolio in one PDF document (max. 300MB). Videos should be included as links, possibly with password (Cloud, Homepage or Vimeo, YouTube). The first pages of your portfolio should contain your name and registration number, your CV and motivation letter. All documents can be uploaded after registration.

<u>Portfolio reviews:</u> To give you the opportunity to show your work and to talk with teachers for support and advice we offer regular <u>portfolio reviews</u> from April 2023 on. <u>Letter of intent:</u> in a text of max. one A4 page you should state your motivation and interests to continue your studies in the Master Program for Architecture at the Academy of fine Arts Vienna. Text: German or English

<u>Language Competency</u>: Please be aware that you have to proof your knowledge of the German and the English language (Level B2) before admission but latest before registration.

<u>Admission to study</u>: After successfully passing the admission test, you must register in person at the registrar's office (study department) with all required documents.
