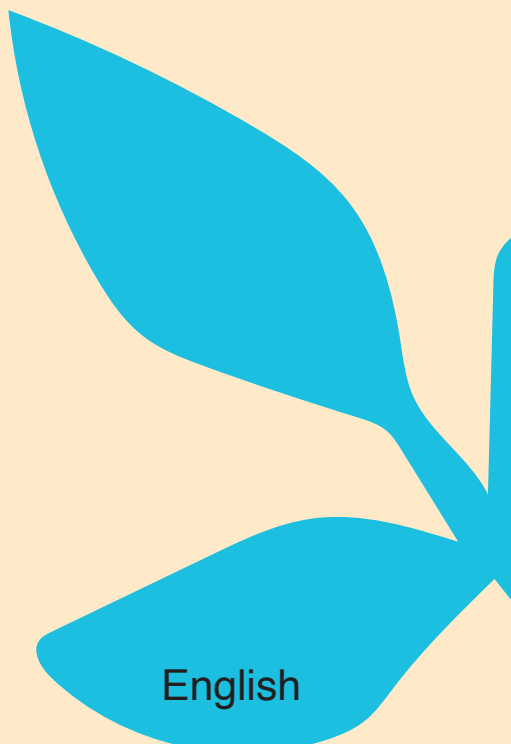

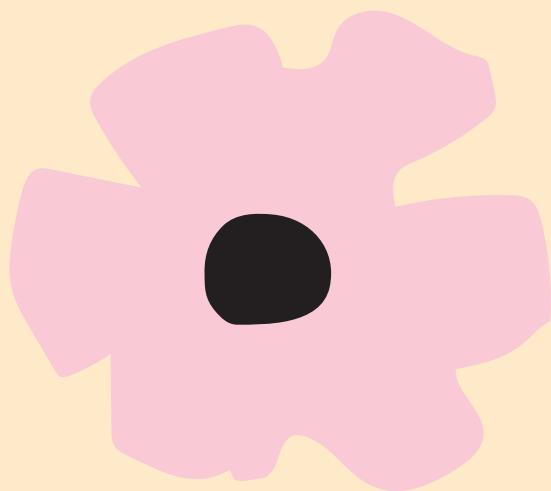
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Welcome at the Academy of Fine Arts Vienna!

Online Pre-Registration

Enrolment to Study

After pre-registration, including the provision of statistical data, please upload the required documents and then transfer the correct amount of the tuition fee/ÖH fee with your reference number.

Tuition Fees

For admission to study, the correct amount must be paid by the end of the registration period, otherwise you risk to not being enrolled or being deregistered!

The regulations regarding the amount and possible exemptions from tuition fees depend on a range of different requirements. Under certain circumstances a fee waiver or refund of the fees can be granted. Please find more information on our website.

The students' union fee (ÖH-Beitrag) is not part of the tuition fees and must be paid each semester by all students without exception.

German Language Courses for Students

The Academy of Fine Arts Vienna offers German language classes for students in the Fine Arts and Scenography programs to reach the level B1. From language level A2 students also have the option to attend the seminar Foreign Languages for Artists. If places are still available, students from other programs (e.g. PhD) may participate in the German courses (see link general study information).

If you cannot attend the German courses organized by the Academy, you will need to attend external courses to reach the required German level before entering the third semester.

IT Service for Students

Once completed the enrolment at the Registrar's Office, you will receive your login data for AkademieOnline, where the following services are available:



With your PIN code and your matriculation number you can activate your student account and use many services:

Academy PrintCard: students of the Academy receive a print card at their institute. Credits can be bought at the office of your institute or in the library. Printing, copying and scanning is possible from all printers at the Academy.

After arriving in Austria, please check the following requirements:

Mandatory Residence Registration

By law all people living in Austria have to register their place of residence at the registration office. All information, contacts of the registration service centres, online reservation for appointments, application form and required documents are available on the website of the city of Vienna.

The residence registration is not connected to any visa or residence permit!

Registration Certificate for EU and EEA nationals

All EU and EEA citizens residing in Austria longer than 3 months need to apply for the registration certificate at the competent authority, the Municipal Department 35 (MA35). Please consult the website of the city of Vienna for further information about contacts, online reservation for appointments and application forms.

Residence permit for non-EU and non-EEA nationals

You have to apply for a residence permit either in advance at an Austrian authority abroad, or after arriving in Vienna at the Municipal Department 35 (MA35). 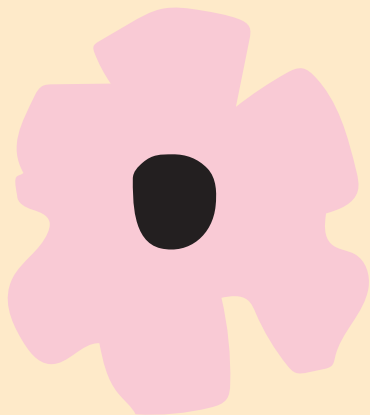
The Academy of Fine Arts Vienna offers the following counselling and service for students with impairments, disabilities or illnesses:

- Advice and mediation in course matters, for example changes of modes of assessment and teaching.
- Counselling and support in organization of technical equipment, e.g. assistive hearing devices for students with hearing impairment.
- Individual support in the organization of a personal assistance or a sign language interpreter.
- Support in all matters of the accessibility of the Academy buildings.
- Counselling in all matters of digital accessibility.
- Counselling on financial support.
- Information on rights of students with impairments, disabilities or illnesses, e.g. sabbatical semester, waiver of tuition fees.

Psychological counselling for students

The Academy of Fine Arts Vienna offers its students psychological counselling and support with:

- Problems, crises, and conflicts, both in creative-artistic work as well as private life
- Difficulties in working together with study colleagues and teachers
- Uncertainties and fears, also in view of planning for the future
- Emotional conditions that are difficult to deal with when alone

Counselling, crisis intervention, short-term psychotherapies, as well as referrals to other professionals are offered. Counselling is offered free of charge and is of course confidential; by request also anonymous.

Equal treatment and anti-discrimination

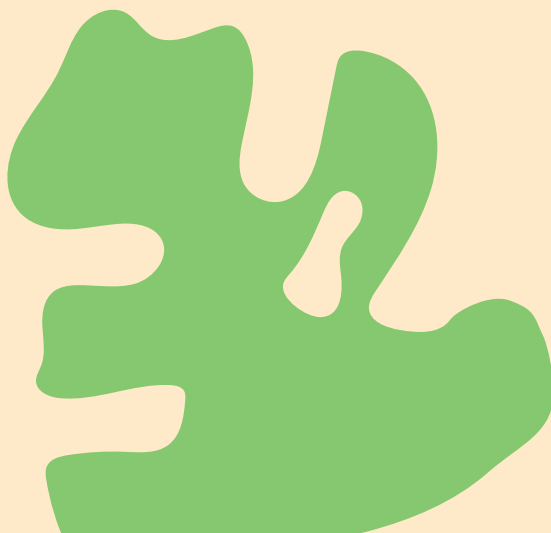


Austrian Students' Union
